#### MEMORIAL OF SAINT HENRY – 13<sup>TH</sup> JULY

973-1024. This Holy Roman Emperor was born in Bavaria and succeeded his father, Henry the Quarrelsome, as Duke of Bavaria in 995, becoming emperor in 1002. A main political aim was to unite the German Empire and this he largely achieved. However, he used the Church for political ends but, after being crowned by the pope in 1013, he restored property and wealth in several seas and founded that of Bamberg, where he built both the cathedral and a monastery.

#### MEMORIAL OF SAINT CAMILLUS OF LELLIS – 14<sup>TH</sup> JULY

1550-1614. Camillus was born in Italy; he joined the Venetian army to fight against the Turks. At the age of 25, he lost everything in gambling, experienced a religious conversion and tried to be a Franciscan, but his health prevented him from being professed. He joined the hospital of San Giacomo in Rome, where he became bursar. Camillus became a priest, and founded in 1585 a congregation of male nurses, who served the plague-stricken, the sick and prisoners.

#### MEMORIAL OF SAINT BONAVENTURE – 15<sup>TH</sup> JULY

1218-74. Born near Orvieto, Italy, he became a Master of the Franciscan school in Paris. At the age of 36, he was elected Minister-General of the Franciscan Order. In 1265 he was nominated Archbishop of York, but rejected the honour. He took a prominent part at the Council of Lyons, summoned to effect reunion with the separated churches of the East. He was a man of gentle courtesy, compassion and accessibility.
